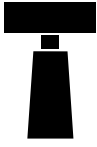

Inspired by the traditional lamps found in public libraries, the versatile Caret promises to become an essential design in daily life.

When Matteo Fogale embarked on a new lamp, he knew he wanted to create a practical solution to the increasingly blurred boundaries between work and home. The result was a portable piece that reimagines the linear silhouettes of the classic, green-shaded designs – known as “bankers lamps” – found in historic libraries.

Named Caret after the V-shaped grapheme used in proofreading and typography to indicate that additional material needs to be inserted into the text, the lamp’s name reflects its multifaceted nature. “I love the idea that this is exactly what this portable lamp is meant to do – to be added to your bookshelf in between your books or sat on a table in between people,” says Fogale.

Made entirely from lacquered steel, the design features a rounded base and a long, pyramid-shaped top that emits a soft, diffused light. The lamp comes in two contemporary colours: Dark Burgundy and Silk Grey.

“The colour choice is an important component in ensuring that Caret can complement different furniture settings,” Fogale adds. “Both colours are quite elegant and will endure the passing of time and trends, and they work well with both dark and light wood tones.”

Born in Uruguay to an Italian family, Fogale was raised in a vibrant environment that melded European influences with local South American arts and crafts. After moving to Italy in 2001, Fogale studied at the Art School Leonardo da Vinci and IUAV University of Venice. In 2015, a collection that he’d launched in collaboration with Laetitia de Allegri was awarded a Wallpaper* Design Award. Now based in London, his work blends the generous forms and honest materials of Brazilian design with the more rigorous principles that underscore Scandinavian design.
